

Pastor's Victory Plan

Preach about Marriage

Commit to preaching on marriage. Ask your congregation to vote YES on prop 102. Make it clear that a YES vote on prop 102 secures marriage by amending the Arizona Constitution to define marriage as the union of one man and one woman.

• Encourage sign distribution and consider posting signs at the church

Post and distribute signs; either large, medium, or yard signs and/or encourage others to do so as well.

• Hand out bulletin inserts and play video announcements

Include a bulletin insert or add appropriate language to your Sunday bulletin announcements. Show your choice of three video segments on DVD and the 30 second spot during services and/or sermons.

Help with phone calls
